

Week 10




1 Reflexive verbs

Tú	te llamas	te sorprendes	te vistes			
Él, ella, usted	se llama	se sorprende	se viste			
Nosotros/as	nos llamamos	nos sorprendemos	nos vestimos			
Vosotros/as	os llamáis	os sorprendéis	os vestís			
Ellos/as, ustedes	se llaman	se sorprenden	se visten



3 Irregular verbs


Look at this table of common irregular verbs. NB: SALIR is only irregular in the 1st person singular (yo), as is HACER. There are quite a lot of this type of verb in Spanish:


